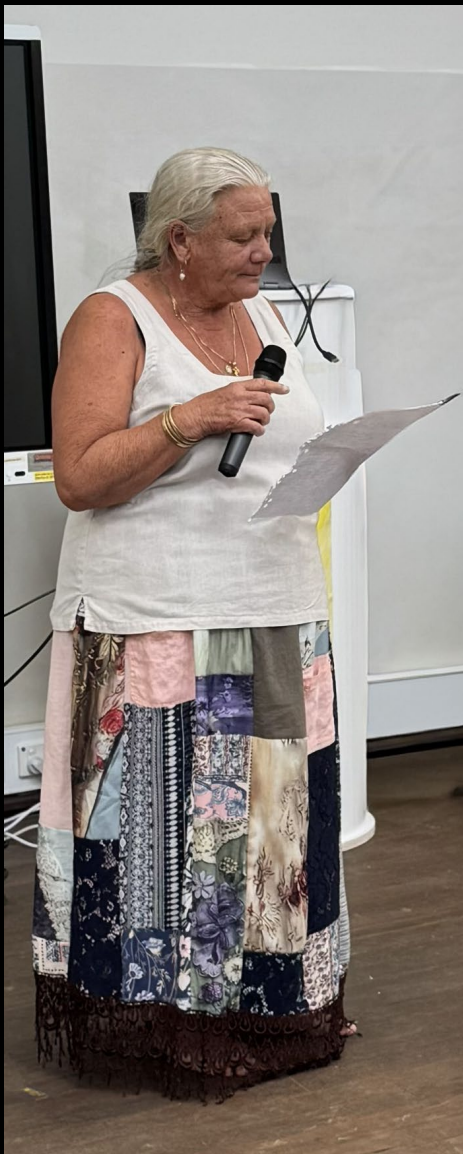




Take fabric printed with Rose's artwork "Blue and Green", and an order for a dress with sleeves from Ali Kent MLA and pass it to Pam.

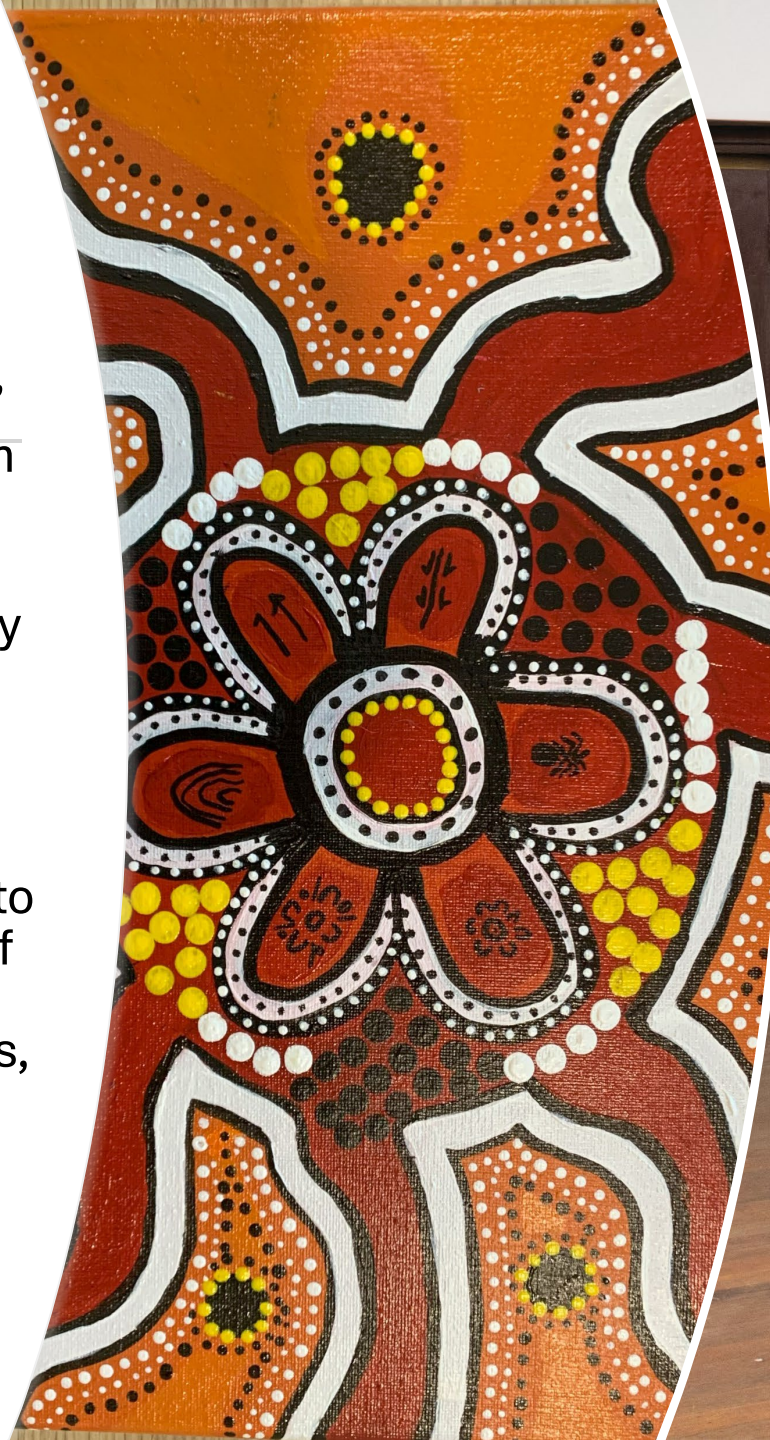

Designed and created by Pam the components were sourced from the Judumul Gallery Clothes 4-You

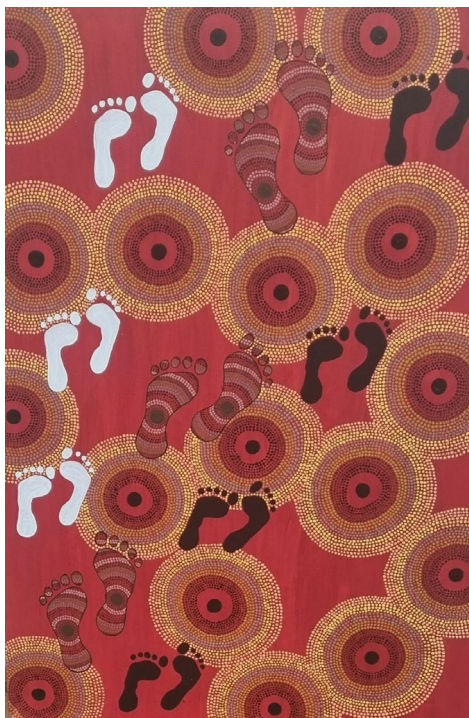




Artwork for the patterned fabric by Rose Mitchell. This glorious fabric has been teamed with fabric released from our Clothes-4-You outlet.
